The rocky, volcanic soil and steep south-facing slopes of the Bugay Vineyards are ideal for producing intensely flavorful Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine is full and structured with wonderful dark cherry, black plum, and mineral notes. This wine is perfectly balanced with enough acidity to pair with marbled beef and savory cheese.
